5. Approval of the Valley Schools Insurance Group ("VSIG"), Valley Schools Workers' Compensation Group ("VSWCG"), Valley Schools Employee Benefits Group ("VSEBG"), and Valley Schools Management Group ("VSMG") financial statement for the month of December 2022 - Laura Felten.

<u>VSIG</u> – Laura Felten reviewed the VSIG financial statements in detail. Jim Migliorino inquired about the possible need for contributions to be increased, and Laura stated she will be meeting with members to discuss this and reinsurance. A conversation took place regarding reinsurance. Mike Barragan stated that Cyber Security was also a challenge, and conversation took place. It was noted that School Districts are considered too risky in the market. Jim Migliorino added that he was told multi-factor authentication was part of the solution. Several ideas were discussed.

<u>VSWCG</u> – Laura Felten reviewed the VSWCG financial statements in detail. Bill Maas asked about unallocated loss adjustments and expenses, and a short discussion took place. Mike Barragan inquired about variance, and Laura addressed.

<u>VSEBG</u> – Laura Felten reviewed the VSEBG financial statements in detail, noting that claims are currently down.

6. Discuss/review Valley Schools Insurance Group, Valley Schools Workers' Compensation Group, Valley Schools Employee Benefits Group, and Valley Schools Management Group Audit Reports for year-end June 30, 2022 – Jim DiCello/Laura Felten.

Jim DiCello reviewed the VSIG, VSWCG, VSEBG, and VSMG audits, noting that the auditors were very pleased overall. He reminded the Board that all three opinions are unmodified opinions and stated that the GASB 87 entry delayed the completion of the audits.

Laura Felten added that Steve Harris retired, and a new partner was added to REDW this year; however, the rest of the team were the same people we have worked with for the last several years.

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<u>VSIG</u> – Jim DiCello reviewed the VSIG audit with the Board, stating it was a break-even year for this group.

VSWCG - Jim DiCello reviewed the VSWCG audit with the Board.

<u>VSEBG</u> -Jim DiCello reviewed the VSEBG audit with the Board. There was a positive change in net position.

<u>VSMG</u> – Jim DiCello reviewed the VSMG audit with the Board. He stated that this audit was modified as a result of the modified cash basis, noting that we don't recognize the pension liability (ASRS). There was a slight increase in net position. It was a clean opinion.

7. Executive Director Member Services summary report and update – Tom Elliott.

Tom Elliott discussed the VSEBG medical and dental summary reports. He reviewed various members, their claims data, and the medical program increases. He stated there was no increase in the dental pool or prepaid dental. He noted that Life insurance is increasing, and Mr. Boone added that this is because the loss ratio is high. Companies are now seeing claims for what took place during COVID.

8. Chairman/CEO summary report and update – Tom Boone.

Tom Boone reviewed the list of future conferences and reminded the Board of the April Board meeting date.

9. Board Member comments.

Bill Maas noted that the AASA conference is to take place soon, provided details.

Jim DiCello gave a report on his experience with the UHC Real Appeal program.

Ken Hicks acknowledged the VSEBG compliance conference, stated he has received positive feedback, and thanked the Valley Schools staff. He also acknowledged Kendall Taylor and thanked her and the Wellness Department for assistance she and her team have provided.
